


# Wednesday, November 5th The Bible Walk in Mansfield

### **Notes From Pastor Eli!**

My friend, how many times have you run across one of those scripture where you stopped and asked your-self, "Could God mean what He says in this verse?" One of the passages that falls into this category is 1 Thessalonians 5:18, "Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

That is a tough command to obey, isn't it? Some of us will respond, "you mean God expects me to give thanks when I am going through a financial, relational, vocational or health crisis? "The Biblical answer is "Yes"--despite the obvious difficulty involved. "Give thanks in all circumstance..." All circumstances means exactly what it says. It encompasses all relationships, all situations, all adversities and problems of life that you and I will ever face.

Friends, please know, giving thanks in all circumstances does not have anything to do with our feelings. None of us feels like giving thanks when the car has a flat tire, the water pipe breaks, or we've just received bad news from the doctor. Neither does giving thanks in all circumstances have anything to do with what appears to be rational, human understanding. Check out Habakkuk 3:17-19 to see a man giving thanks when circumstances and reason would strongly vote against it. What is rational about giving thanks when you've discovered your spouse is having an affair or you've found drugs in your son or daughter's bedroom.

Giving thanks in all circumstances is a deliberate choice we make based on God's perfect wisdom. It is God's will and purpose for us to give thanks in all circumstances because God understands how an attitude of gratitude can influence our lives and those around us.

Giving thanks in all circumstances helps keep you and me aware of God's presence. Our God can and will work out His sovereign plan--regardless of the evil we may experience. Nothing can stop God's good purpose, or His love, for your life or mine. Read Romans 8:28-38 again, for it reminds us that God works for good in all things. Giving thanks in all circumstances is not easy. But, it is a transforming process where you and I will find our joy increasing, our love deepening, and our strength flourishing beyond our problems or crisis.
